

The Blessing of God's Word Hearing from our TWR360 Users

Ken and Tammy Cummins are dear friends of TWR. Ken is general manager of two radio stations in Kentucky, WNKJ and WNLJ, that minister the gospel of Jesus Christ in their area while also partnering with TWR to raise money for world missions. Ken and Tammy are also experienced missionaries, and Ken loves to travel to teach and encourage pastors in the Word of God. Ken's most recent trip was to Mexico where he bumped into an interesting connection with TWR360. Here is Ken's account of the trip:

God does marvelous things and I still get surprised! Recently I was part of an annual mission trip to Zacatecas, Mexico. Now in its 12th year, the primary objective of the trip is to teach and train pastors based on a curriculum used by New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary.

On Tuesday, July 24th, I went to the home of Pastor Desi Adame to get supplies and equipment stored at his house. After greeting him and his wife Celia, my eyes immediately made contact with the TWR logo on a little container. I noticed the words *A Través de La Biblia* on it (*Thru the Bible* in Spanish) and immediately asked Brother Desi exactly what he had. His youngest brother lives in Dallas and had sent him the "memoria" (flash drive) that contained all 66 books of the Bible taught by J. Vernon McGee and had introduced Brother Desi to the broadcast and to TWR. Brother Desi and

Celia have been impacted by the teachings. He is currently studying in the book of Acts. I asked if he had downloaded the TWR360 app onto his smartphone, and he had not, so I set up a time the following Saturday to come back to their home to show them the app and get a full interview about how they are using the studies and what impact they are having on his ministry.

Desi and Celia both have the app on their phones now and are promoting TWR360 by handing out the information cards about how to get the app onto the phones of their contacts — believers and non-believers alike. Desi's

brother Luis Armando Adame is preparing to be a pastor as well. The Lord has totally changed Armando's life. At dinner on the following Sunday evening, I was able to show him the app, and he now is using it and sharing it with others. This area of Zacatecas is less than 1% Christian and is filled with syncretism and strongholds. Like many in the world, they desperately need the Lord.

Brother Desi is leading a small church that gathers in his home for worship. He is using *Thru the Bible* materials through the connection with TWR360. In addition to the small group in his home, Desi is currently building a church building in Zacatecas, an area that is completely unevangelized. In fact, one area in Zacatecas is known for the worship of the idol El Niño

Desi and Celia are teaching children and youth by sharing the stories of the Bible with them. Brother Desi, Celia and Armando are reaching out to the children so they can hear the truth. TWR360 will be shared with hundreds and hopefully even thousands in this unreached region.

The blessing of sharing TWR360 didn't stop with Desi. I took time during my teaching sessions during the conference to share with the 30 plus pastors and leaders in my classes about TWR360 and discuss it with them. Only one pastor in the group had heard about it. Now they are going to use TWR360 in their teaching and discipleship programs and also share the app with others.

On Sunday morning, July 29th, I preached at Iglesia Bautista El Buen Pastor in Fresnillo, Zacatecas, Mexico. At the close of my message, I shared about TWR360 with the congregation

of over 100 people. The ushers took the information cards to each worshipper that wanted one. Later, 22-year-old Guillermo Corral Páez, who goes by the name "Memito," came up to me and asked if I had any of the promotional cards left over. I gave him what I had. He is going to get them into the hands of the youth and others in the community. Pastor José Luis Robles "Pepe," who has pastored the church for 25 years, told me that Memito is going to give his first 15-minute devotion in front of the church on Sunday, August 5th, using the materials he has downloaded from the TWR360 app.
